JUNIA is an engineering school, a non-profit association (Law of 1901), and recognized by the State as being of general interest (EESPIG label). This non-profit status guarantees that all resources directly serve education and research, in a spirit of demanding academic quality.

As a member of the Catholic University of Lille, JUNIA relies on the strength of a large university collective while affirming its core project: **training engineers capable of driving transitions.**

Faithful to its DNA, the school remains guided by the principles that marked its creation:

- **Offer adapted education, rooted in local areas** and open to human, social, international, environmental, and ethical dimensions
- **Train engineers** with both a solid scientific background and a well-developed practical sense
- **Develop excellent research**, serving education and society

Spread across **three campuses** —Lille, Châteauroux, and Bordeaux— JUNIA welcomes over **4,000 students**, including **700 apprentices** and **25% international students**. The diversity of profiles and the richness of the associative, cultural, sports, and civic life create a stimulating and caring environment where everyone can thrive.

THE SCHOOL OF TRANSITIONS

Building on a multidisciplinary foundation of skills, JUNIA prepares its engineers to meet the great challenges of the 21st century.

Environmental, energy, digital, and societal transitions: these are all changes affecting our ways of life, businesses, and local areas, and our graduates are trained to respond to them effectively and creatively.

PROGRAMMES ROOTED IN REALITY

Each JUNIA degree covers a field directly related to the ongoing transitions:

- **The JUNIA HEI Programme Sustainable energy, industries, and buildings:** supporting the transformation of industrial models, the mutation of infrastructures, and the emergence of more energy-efficient solutions. Civil engineering, robotics, materials, smart buildings, responsible industry: these are all areas for inventing new solutions.
- **The JUNIA ISA Programme Agriculture, food, and environment:** rethinking our connection to life, developing sustainable agricultural practices, ensuring food security, managing resources, and preserving ecosystems. An education focused on ecological transition and food sovereignty.

- **The JUNIA ISEN Programme Digital technology, electronics, and smart systems:** training those who design, control, and secure digital technologies. IT, electronics, data, AI, cybersecurity, smart networks: constantly evolving professions where innovation and digital sovereignty are at the heart of tomorrow's challenges.

- **The JUNIA XP programmes Professional transitions and new professions:** supporting non-linear career paths and career evolution. Offering training accessible throughout life, including full-time, work-study, or continuing education, to prepare talents for the emerging needs of companies and local areas.

Thanks to this comprehensive and transversal offer, JUNIA trains engineers capable of combining knowledge, working on projects, and innovating in direct connection with companies, research laboratories, and local areas. Open to the world, the school welcomes 20% of students from all over the world each year and offers many mobility opportunities.

Social science courses have always been part of JUNIA's pedagogical philosophy. This heritage is reflected in a human and humanist education found in all programmes, aiming to equip students with the means to develop shared values, critical consciousness, and sensitivity to societal issues.

JUNIA has chosen to give a significant place to the international dimension. Over the years, JUNIA has forged partnerships with more than 340 universities around the world.

With its renowned partners, JUNIA establishes collaborations in the fields of research and pedagogy, co-develops joint and double-degree programmes, European and international projects, and more.

To guarantee the visibility of its activities internationally, JUNIA is also active with official bodies abroad (Campus France Network, Embassies) and thematic international networks.

JUNIA also multiplies partnerships with companies to help economic actors recruit and train the international talents they need. Finally, JUNIA's international influence is also channeled through its Alumni who are ambassadors of



the school in the professional world.

JUNIA also offers a multicultural experience on a daily basis. This includes programmes entirely taught in English, study trips in

Europe, welcoming international professors, and the development of academic partnerships such as international Master's degrees and double degrees.



A holder of the Erasmus Charter, JUNIA commits to respecting the fundamental principles and values of European programmes: equal opportunities, openness to others, and humanism. Within the framework of Erasmus+, JUNIA is involved in programmes dedicated to student mobility (for studies or internships) and staff mobility (for teaching and training), in strategic partnerships, International Credit Mobility projects, and in welcoming professors and professionals from other institutions worldwide.

JUNIA has also been awarded the 3-star "Bienvenue en France" label. This label recognizes the quality of the welcome and support provided to international students at our school.

A MULTICULTURAL SCHOOL

Each year, JUNIA welcomes international students. They represent, on average, 25% of students on campus. With its partners worldwide, JUNIA has co-designed “bridge programmes” to allow them to acquire the necessary prerequisites in their home country to continue their studies in France at graduate level.

JUNIA offers all its international students a welcome programme to facilitate their arrival in France and their integration into the school.

This orientation session includes intensive French language courses, intercultural communication, individual guidance support, as well as logistical and administrative assistance before and during their stay in France (assistance with accommodation, VISA, insurance, etc.). International mobility also concerns all staff.

Each year, JUNIA welcomes about a hundred visiting international professors and sends just as many abroad. JUNIA's student and staff mobility policy thus promotes high-value multicultural exchanges on campus.

Founded in 1875, the Lille Catholic University is a multidisciplinary institution that brings together 5 Faculties, 17 Schools of business and engineering, and health and social care colleges.

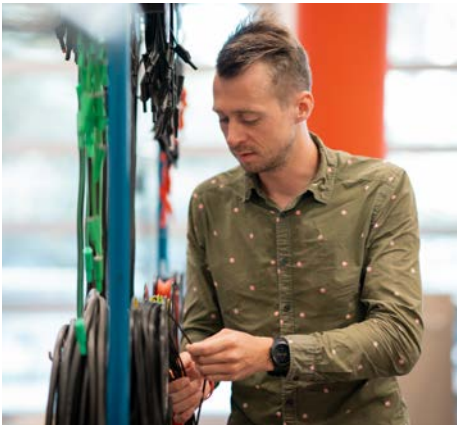

The Career Center offers all students a comprehensive path from defining their professional path to their entry into their first job. Additional courses and workshops are set up for international students to give them the codes for French company recruitment. Every student thus benefits from personalized support on each of the three campuses.

The Career Center also means:

- **More than 30 student conferences** on HR and professional integration topics
- **Interview simulations** with professional recruiters
- **Exclusive meetings** with partner companies
- **A dedicated platform** for internship offers and professional integration

Each year, the Career Center organizes 4 major events dedicated to recruitment:

- **The Companies Forum in autumn:** a multi-campus, in-person event in Lille that brings together over **180 companies**
- **JUNIA International Job Dating in winter:** a multi-campus, 100% remote event with the participation of over **45 companies** offering international opportunities
- **The Apprenticeship Companies Forum in spring:** a multi-campus, **100% remote event** with the participation of over **180 companies** to allow students to find their work-study contract
- **Apprenticeship Fair on the Bordeaux campus** in April: with the participation of over 30 companies

WHEN STUDENT LIFE MEANS PASSION & ACTION

Student and associative life allows JUNIA students to open up to others, share their passions, discover new ones, develop complementary skills, and flourish.

MORE THAN JUST ASSOCIATIVE LIFE, A COLLECTIVE EXPERIENCE

During their studies, students can get involved in an association and take part in the life of the school in general. There are over **100 associations** distributed across the 3 campuses. By getting involved in the associative and student life of their campus, students have the opportunity to develop new skills, take on responsibilities, and gain autonomy. These are assets they can capitalize on throughout their professional lives.

Involvement in campus associative life is taken into account in the academic evaluation. This evaluation considers the regularity and seriousness of their project throughout the year.

THE STUDENT UNION (BDE) AND ASSOCIATIONS

At JUNIA, associative life plays a central role in the daily lives of students. Coordinated by the Bureau des Élèves (BDE - Student Union) on each campus, it offers everyone the possibility to fully engage in the school's dynamic. Students can join an existing association or choose to create a new one according to their wishes and interests.

Associative activities cover a wide range of fields: artistic (visual arts, theater, music, photo, video, cooking...), solidarity and humanitarian (social actions, international missions, tutoring...), but also event planning, student



services (organizing parties and trips, welcoming newcomers, animating student life), as well as projects related to business and technologies. Throughout the year, these initiatives help create a friendly, dynamic, and enriching environment for the entire student community.

Students are supported by JUNIA teams to carry out their associative projects, a true enrichment of their educational path.

SPORTS ASSOCIATION

The JUNIA Sports Association coordinates the school's sports activities on all 3 campuses. It offers **40 sports with regular practice**, ranging from recreational sports to competition: team sports (football, volleyball, basketball, rugby, handball, hockey, futsal, American football...) or individual sports (tennis, horse riding, archery, badminton, track and field, climbing, golf, karting...), dance (classical, modern, rock, cheerleading), water sports (sailing, swimming, kite-surfing, rowing, water polo...), and combat sports (fencing, judo, kickboxing...).

Furthermore, it organizes a dozen annual events (cross-country race, show jumping, raid, surfing, skiing, prestige rock party).

In research, JUNIA's ambition revolves around the major environmental, agricultural, energy, digital, and industrial transitions, in connection with the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

This approach is rooted in JUNIA's DNA, based on scientific excellence, responsible innovation, and multidisciplinary.

Committed to its local presence and strongly involved in the academic and scientific ecosystem of its three campuses, JUNIA leverages its scientific and technological assets to help companies and communities find concrete solutions to initiate these transitions at their level.

The diversity of scientific fields and academic offer, as well as the quality of its research activities, place JUNIA as a recognized Institute of Science and Technology, dedicated to supporting transitions within companies and territories.

USEFUL AND COMMITTED RESEARCH

AN EXPERT IN THE DESIGN AND PRODUCTION OF DEMONSTRATORS

Over the years, JUNIA has developed proven and recognized expertise in the design and production of demonstrators.

It currently has 4 demonstrators that allow testing innovative and emerging solutions in real-life situations:

■ **“Smartgrid”** and **“Smartmobility”** on the consumption and renewable production of electricity

■ **“Smartfarming”** focusing on the challenges of tomorrow’s sustainable food production

■ **“Factory 4.0”** for additive manufacturing, computer-aided manufacturing, and maintenance in augmented reality

To maximize societal impact and contribute to the acceptability of new technologies, JUNIA mobilizes all its human, scientific, and technical resources. More than ever, research at JUNIA is designed as a driving force for innovation and a lever for transformation, without losing sight of the need to capitalize on research activities to ensure the sustainability of its economic model.

Research is at the heart of JUNIA’s DNA. Tell us more.

Born from the merger of 3 major engineering schools, HEI, ISA, and ISEN, JUNIA immediately established the link between its training programmes and research. We have about a hundred teacher-researchers who divide their time between teaching and research, as well as 6 jointly supervised laboratories, the newest of which, BioPrev, will start its activities in January 2026. In this context, JUNIA has also developed solid and lasting industrial partnerships. Finally, the school is strongly involved in high-societal-impact projects with companies and local authorities.

In a constantly evolving world, what are the development axes for research within JUNIA?

Research at JUNIA covers a wide spectrum of themes, from life science to nanotechnologies, including acoustics, energy, IoT, AI, connected agriculture, reclamation of degraded soils, sustainable buildings and cities, health and well-being engineering, and future food. We address these different subjects through the lens of the major ongoing transitions, and with state-of-the-art equipment. In this approach, we develop demonstrators that are then



deployed in real-life usage conditions. In the field of urban planning, we are working on Smart Cities and future housing, urban mobility, etc.. In the health field, we are continuing the development of our chemical library, which already has over 4,200 molecules and will allow us to work on potential therapeutic candidates.

What are JUNIA’s strengths in research?

First of all, our multidisciplinary approach involves researchers with diverse yet complementary expertise to serve research and innovation. In parallel, JUNIA has also forged strong and lasting partnerships with the business world, which allows us to root our research efforts in the reality of local areas and their needs. This dimension, moreover, echoes our EESPIG status and our commitment to the public interest, particularly at the local level.

Labeled **GEIQ Employment & Disability** and in line with its CSR approach, JUNIA pays particular attention to accessibility in the broadest sense. The school offers adaptations and accommodations to special-need students.

These accommodations are applied case by case, in accordance with the referent physician from Lille Catholic University's Disability Support Center, or the relevant professional on our Bordeaux and Chateauroux campuses. They often involve extended time, note-takers, provision of computer, specific support for internship search preparation of job interview or workplace adaptation.

STUDENT SERVICES :

JUNIA offers a dedicated support system to help international students into their whole journey from their first day at JUNIA until they graduate. Our international team provides the following services :

- **accommodation in student residences,**
- **administrative procedures: visa, resident permit, health insurance, etc.,**
- **integration into student life: student unions, sports activities, international parties, etc.,**
- **welcome session: intensive French language and intercultural communication courses, orientation week, and more.**



ONE SCHOOL ON 3 CAMPUSES

Over the past decade, JUNIA has evolved from a logic of one institution with three schools to that of a single institution structured across three campuses. Far more than a geographical expansion, it's also a paradigm shift for JUNIA, which now positions itself as a national player strongly anchored in local territories.

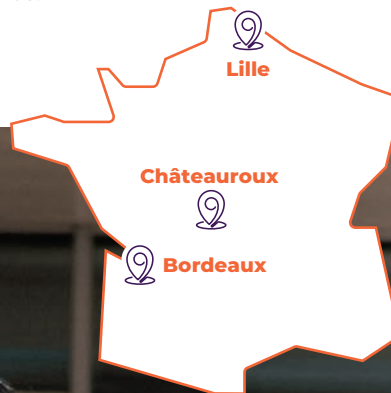
Since 1885, **HEI**, **ISEN** and **ISA** have been located in Lille's Vauban-Esquermes district.

In 2012, JUNIA expanded its geographical footprint with the opening of a campus in Châteauroux. More recently, in February 2020, the school opened in Bordeaux's Francis of Assisi campus.

With campuses in Lille, Châteauroux, and Bordeaux, JUNIA has shifted from being a local player to having a territorialized national dimension. With this new status as a national player, JUNIA is rethinking its actions and interactions with its entire ecosystem, particularly with companies.

"Developing together" by valuing impact research and innovation, social and solidarity entrepreneurship, and territorial anchoring.

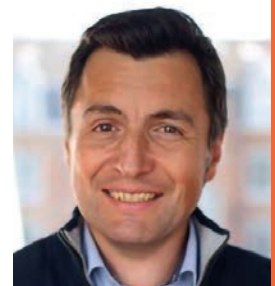
4 PILLAR Governance

JUNIA is strongly committed to CSR and has chosen to call its policy RéSonance 1.5. Tell us more.

This name contains several symbols, including a visual nod to the concept of CSR. It also refers to our professions, particularly the field of resonance on a scientific level. This name also embodies our ambition: to make the SDGs and the Paris Climate Agreements resonate in the daily lives of all our stakeholders: students, teachers, researchers, staff, and economic actors.

How does your commitment translate into action?

JUNIA has adopted an action plan structured around 4 pillars covering 20 areas of action. On the environmental pillar, our ambition is to be exemplary with particular attention to energy performance, biodiversity, waste management, and decarbonization of our models. This also translates into ISO 14001 certification, a relatively rare approach in higher education. On the social pillar, we work on well-being and health with a focus on mental health, inclusion, and disability. On the economic pillar, we focus on the societal impacts of research. We've also developed ODDYSSÉE, a gamified training programme on ecological transition and sustainable development issues for JUNIA and Lille Catholic University students, businesses... Finally, the last pillar relates to governance.

How do you involve students?

From their arrival at JUNIA, all our students are made aware of and trained in CSR issues and best practices. They must pass the TASK certificate, The Assessment of Sustainability Knowledge. They also have the opportunity to contribute through projects such as conducting CSR diagnoses or audits for the school... They can become CSR coordinators within student associations and their class to relay our sustainability actions. This involvement is taken into account in their evaluation and valued in their grades.
